From the article: "A lack of equal treatment on bond issues has prevented tribes from fully exploring that option for raising funds, as tribes must deal with red tape that states and local governments don't encounter, according to Carter Ledyard & Milburn LLP partner Steven P. McSloy. 'It really does boil down to a fairness issue,' McSloy said. 'The smallest town in America can issue tax-exempt bonds categorically, but an Indian nation has to go through a process. That's why we haven't seen enough activity.'"
