

Village Planning Board Sides with Carter Ledyard Client, Blocking Development of Environmentally Sensitive Site on the Long Island Sound

Carter Ledyard client Mamaroneck Coastal Environment Coalition achieved a major milestone last week when the Village of Mamaroneck Planning Board denied the applications of Hampshire Recreation LLC to construct a 105-unit subdivision on a flood-prone Critical Environmental Area adjacent to the Long Island Sound. The Planning Board ultimately agreed with MCEC's position that the proposed development was inconsistent with Village law and would cause significant adverse environmental impacts.
